It is sometimes termed mining geology or applied geology. It treats of the occurrence, distribution, and origin of mineral deposits. In general the economic geologist is expected to answer the questions: Where is the deposit? Why is it where it is? To what depth is it likely to extend? What changes are likely to take place in it with increasing depth? How shall one find the continuation of a deposit that is lost? The practising economic geologist is expected to appraise mines and prospects or estimate their value and to recommend development work that will reveal at minimum cost any deposits that are not exposed. He is expected also to have a general knowledge of the distribution of deposits of the valuable minerals. Changes in mining, milling, and metallurgic practice are continually taking place and such changes may make it possible to treat at a satisfactory profit material that was formerly valueless.
