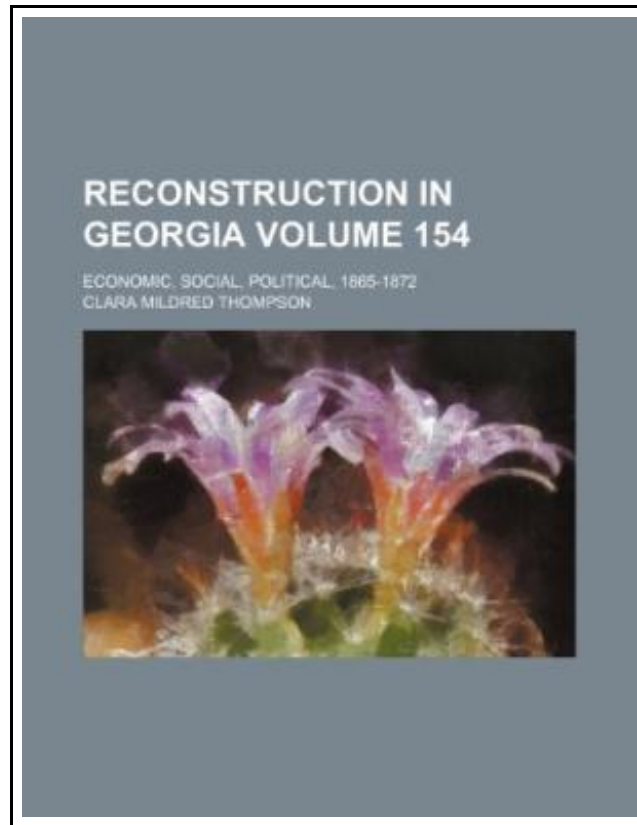

As an accompaniment of reconstruction the Methodist Episcopal Church entered the field in Atlanta, starting a church for its Northern members in 1867. Negro churches, Baptist and Methodist, likewise appeared. The most significant of the daily papers were the Macon Telegraph, Augusta Chronicle, Savannah News, Atlanta Intelligencer and Columbus Enquirer. It was an important part of reconstruction policy to foster a favorable public opinion through the press. This was done in various ways. Under military rule newspapers were severely dealt with for publishing anti-reconstruction editorials.¹ But a more effective means of securing favorable press opinion was through patronage, not a small instrument with the publication of multitudinous official proclamations and notices. Where established papers could not be won over, the Republicans established papers of their own, kept alive by patronage from the state more than by earnings from subscribers or commercial advertisements.
